BALLET SUN VALLEY 2021 COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

Ballet Sun Valley, along with the Sun Valley Music Festival and Sun Valley Writers' Conference, has engaged 9 Foundations, Inc. (9F) a company founded by Dr. Joe Allen, associate professor at the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health, for expert consulting services on safe operation in the wake of SARS-CoV-2/COVID-19.

9F is comprised of Harvard-affiliated experts in the fields of public health, infectious disease transmission and intervention, worker health and safety, and risk assessment and mitigation, 9 Foundations advises organizations on best practices for safe reopening in the wake of COVID-19.

BSV plans to seat the Pavilion at 100% capacity while implementing the protocols outlined below. This plan is supported by several factors, including the fact that performances take place in a well-ventilated, outdoor venue, and the community has a very high vaccination rate and very low case counts.

OUTDOOR PROTOCOLS – Sun Valley Pavilion and Lawn

- **Fully Vaccinated Individuals:** If an individual is fully vaccinated, they do not need to wear a mask but may do so at their discretion.
- **Unvaccinated Individuals:** If an individual is unvaccinated, based on current CDC guidance, BSV strongly suggests they wear a mask outdoors if they are unable to maintain physical distance.

UNIVERSAL PRECAUTIONS

Universal precautions should be applied to all activities at the Sun Valley Pavilion.

- Stay home when sick.
- Practice good hand hygiene:
 - Wash hands often with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds.
 - If soap and warm water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. Hand sanitizer should be made readily available in common areas and at building entrances.
 - Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth.

All protocols are based on current vaccine trends and disease dynamics, which may change in the coming months. All seating plans and protocols are subject to change to support a safe environment for our audience.
